- Applied for funding (\$125,000) from the Kresge Foundation's Emerging Leaders in Public Health leadership development initiative for \$125,000. Our transformative concept integrates a public health approach into the criminal justice system by partnering with the Mental Health Diversion Program (MHDP) in Sarpy County. *Not awarded*.
- Applied for funding (up to \$100,00) Phase I from the Aetna Foundation Cultivating Healthy Communities grant to support activities to prevent and reduce exposures to environmental health hazards through enhanced surveillance, testing, and public awareness campaigns. *Pending selection to Phase II*.
